CONSULAR REMARKS

REQUIREMENTS FOR TEMPORARY VISITOR'S VISA:

Nationals of countries that have diplomatic relations with the Philippines are generally allowed entry into the country without visas for a maximum stay of 21 days or less, provided the nature of the trip is for tourism/vacation; the travelers possess valid passport (at least six months to one year at the time of travel); and present a roundtrip airline ticket or confirmed onward booking to another country. THERE ARE, HOWEVER, EXCEPTIONS. The maximum length of stay, which is extendible with immigration authorities in the Philippines, is 59 days. Please check with the Consulate for further information.

PROCEDURE FOR FILING THE APPLICATION (EITHER WALK-IN OR BY MAIL):

- () 1. A) Complete and submit application F.A. Form No. 2 (walk-in or by mail)
B) By mail: application form should be notarized first by your local notary public

- () 2. Submit one (1) 2 x 2 photograph taken within the last six months

- () 3. A) TOURISM: Submit a proof of financial means (e.g. recent bank statement) or Affidavit of Support, attach document(s) as proof of financial capability of affiant), or Certification of Employment or any document to show your present net worth
B) BUSINESS: Submit letter or a written statement from the sponsoring company stating the purpose of the travel, length of stay, and the company(ies) to be visited in the Philippines.

- () 4. SUBMIT ORIGINAL AND PHOTOCOPY OF PASSPORT & AIRLINE TICKET OR CONFIRMED ITINERARY

- () 5. VISA FEES PAYABLE EITHER IN CASH OR MONEY ORDER/CASHIER'S CHECK
 - a) \$30.00 – single entry (three months validity)
 - b) \$60.00 – multiple entry (six months validity)
 - c) \$90.00 – multiple entry (twelve months validity)Other nationals who are required entry visa for 21 days or less:
 - d) \$40.00 – these applicants should also submit a photocopy of their Resident Alien Card or valid INS Permit

- () 6. By mail – REMIT the appropriate amount with additional \$6.00 in money order/cashier's check payable to the Philippine Consulate General, Los Angeles, for return certified mail or enclose a self-addressed certified return envelope.
PLEASE NOTE THAT WE DO NOT ACCEPT PERSONAL CHECK OR PERSONAL MONEY ORDER.

THE CONSULATE ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY LOSS THROUGH THE MAIL.

NOTE: MINOR CHILDREN TRAVELLING, EITHER ALONE OR ACCOMPANIED BY A GUARDIAN, STAYING IN THE PHILIPPINES BEYOND TWENTY-ONE (21) DAYS MUST ALSO APPLY FOR A VISA BEFORE PROCEEDING TO THE PHILIPPINES.

FOR THOSE BELOW FIFTEEN YEARS OLD, REQUIREMENTS FOR THE "WAIVER OF EXCLUSION GROUNDS", (IF APPLICABLE), MAY BE OBTAINED AT THE VISA SECTION. PERSONAL APPEARANCE IS REQUIRED FROM ONE OF THE PARENTS UNLESS APPLICATION WILL BE DONE THROUGH THE MAIL, IN WHICH CASE THE APPLICATION FORM MUST BE NOTARIZED BEFORE MAILING IT TO THE CONSULATE.
